

2020 - Northeast Science Bowl Regional

Advancing and Scoring

The North and South regions will have 42 teams divided into 7 divisions

Teams play all teams in their division, so 5 matches/rounds.

How points are earned

Each round: scoring starts with each team receiving the number of points equal to their score for that match, additionally....

1. A win in the match will add 100 points to that score
2. A tie will add 50 points to that score
3. A loss will add 50 points minus the number of points the team lost by, to a minimum score of zero (examples below):
 - o a. Lose by 1 point \Rightarrow add 49 points
 - o b. Lose by 40 points \Rightarrow add 10 points
 - o c. Lose by 60 points \Rightarrow add 0 points
4. These scores will be added up for all five morning rounds for each team.
5. Each team will also receive an **additional 2.11% divisional strength bonus*****

*** Divisional strength bonus = 2.11% of Division total score (the sum score of all 6 teams within the same division using rules 1-5.)

To choose the 16 teams going into each of the Regional Championships:

- NORTH and SOUTH: the 2 top scoring teams in each of the divisions advance (14 in, 2 to go).
- NORTH and SOUTH: the next 2 top scoring teams, regardless of division, advance.
- A maximum of two teams per school can advance to the championship round.
- The championships will be double elimination.

The remaining teams in the North and the South region along with 12 additional teams will move to the Wildcard Championship.

WILDCARD

The Wildcard Championship will have 60 teams separated into 10 divisions. Each team plays 5 games against divisional foes. We will use the same scoring rubric as the morning rounds. After 5 games the top 8 scoring teams regardless of division will advance to the single elimination Wildcard championships, see page 18 & 24.
